As per the Regulations notified by the Council vide F.No. 37-3/Legal/2004 dated 28<sup>th</sup> November 2005 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee/ Expert Committee, I am directed to convey the extension of approval of the Council to Bharati Vidya Bhawan's S.P.Jain's Institute Of Management Reasearch, Dadabhai Road, Munshi Nagar Andheri(West) , Mumbai - 400 058 for conduct of the following courses with the intake indicated below:-

**Important Note:**

- 1 It has come to the notice of the Council that several unapproved courses are being conducted by the institution(Annexure-1). The institution is advised to apply for AICTE approval for unapproved courses/ programmes in the field of Technical Education as per the regulations notified by the Council vide Notification No. F.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 28<sup>th</sup> November 2005 by 07<sup>th</sup> March 2006 or discontinue conduct of all such unapproved courses/ programmes with immediate effect, failing which this extension of approval for the year 2006-2007 stands withdrawn and further appropriate action shall be initiated against the Institution.
- 2 The institute has made excess admissions of 28 students in the year 2005-2006. The institute has also made 28 excess admissions during the year 2004-2005 which was regularized as a one-time measure after complying with the AICTE rules & regulations by the institute. A letter was issued to this effect, which clearly mentioned that this regularization is a one-time exception and any repetition of such misconduct would render the institution liable for withdrawal of approval.
