SPJIMR recently inaugurated the 9th batch of its Fellow Programme in Management (FPM) at the SPJIMR campus.

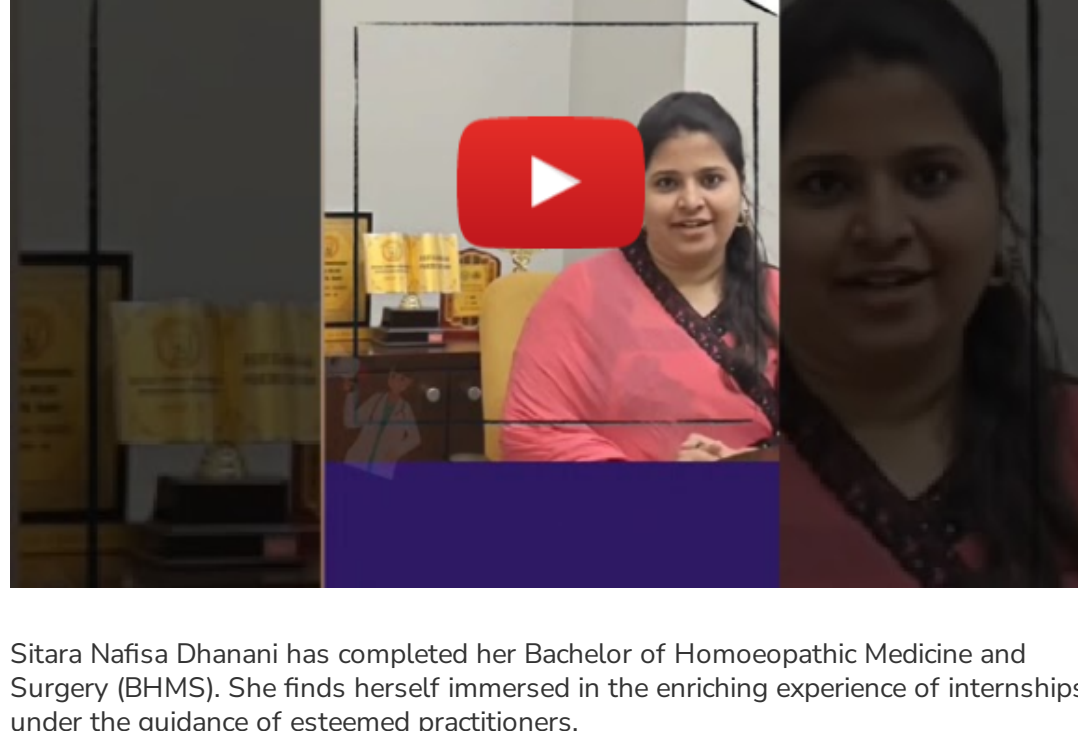
This program combines rigorous research methods with a practical orientation to address pressing business challenges, offering participants the advantage of conducting research in Mumbai, India's business capital.
